Applications now filled out ONLINE

This year we will be keeping the same process for acquiring Kamp reservations but our application process has **drastically changed**. Enclosed in this packet you will find a Club Reservation Form, information on Open House, a Kamp Kiwanis Wish List, one (1) paper application and at least 2(2) Kamp Online Quick Apps. We prefer you utilize the Quick Apps. A family must fill out a quick application and we at Kamp should receive that as soon as possible so that we may send the family a link, a user name and a password to fill out the application.

THESE MUST BE TIMELY. PLEASE DO NOT KEEP THE QUICK APPS ONCE THEY ARE FILLED IN. SEND THEM BACK TO KAMP AS SOON AS THEY ARE FILLED OUT SO THAT THE FAMILY MAY HAVE ACCESS TO THE ACTUAL APPLICATION.

Please throw away any old forms. NYS Health Dept Regulations change from year to year and new formats have been added. Please do not forget the Club Kamper Reservation Form to assist you in reserving Kamp spots.

We here at Kamp understand that this is a new process and that there will be bumps along the way. We ask that you please be patient with this turn over as it is also new to us and that you call Kamp with any questions. We will be happy to answer them.

We have supplied you with a full paper application for families that do not have access to the internet. Our online application is accessible via PC, tablet or smart phone.

2018 Adult Kamp Fees

The Adult Fees for the 2018 season are \$795.00 w/o transportation and \$200.00 for transportation which are the same as last year. The total cost per kamper is \$995.00 with transportation. **A \$200.00 deposit is required for all kampers.** Adult Kamp is filled on a first come, first serve basis.

Special Needs

If you are sponsoring a kamper with Special Needs, please contact Kamp first. We want to have room for every kamper, but we need to assure that there will be enough staff to service each kamper's needs. We only accept 20 kampers that require extra assistance per week. These spaces fill first.

Kamp Dates

Please note that Child Session 1 begins Sunday July 8 and ends on Saturday July 14. Every session afterward will run from the following Sunday to Saturday and so on until our last session, which runs from Sunday August 12 to Saturday August 18. Our data shows that our first few sessions are the hardest to fill, so this should help you. This year we are offering 2 adult sessions.

Club Reservations

Clubs can begin making reservations now for the 2018 summer season. Enclosed you will find a Club Reservation Form that will assist us here at Kamp to make a solid Kamp Reservation. We are unable to hold a spot without the **\$200.00 non-refundable deposit per kamper.**

Transportation

On the back page of the application is this years bussing schedule. We will contact each kamper and each club with bus times as soon as we know them which most often is **Friday at noon** before a kamp session. Drive-in times on Sunday are between **3:00pm** and **4:00pm** and pick-up is between **8:00am** and **8:30am** on closing day. All divisions that provide Drive-ins will be week 4. If this week is not possible please contact the Kamp.

Health Exam Form

All kampers must submit a Current Health Exam that was completed within the 12 months prior to their attendance at Kamp. All kampers must submit the Kamp's Health Exam Form. **Due to State Regulations and American Camp Association requirements, we can not accept alternate health record forms.** If a kamper submits an alternate health exam form we may not be able to accept the kamper into Kamp because it may be missing crucial information.

Complete Applications

Please explain to parents/guardians that an application whether online or on paper must be complete in it's entirety. Each blank space leaves us here at Kamp without valuable information that may assist us in providing your kamper the best possible care. We want to provide your kamper with the best times he or she can have away from home building wonderful memories and friendships.
